



Men contract Legionnaires' at Olympic Park

Two men who visited Sydney's Olympic Park early last month have tested positive to Legionnaires' disease.

New South Wales Health says the men, aged in their 40s and 50s, were treated in hospital and have been discharged.

Testing on cooling towers at Olympic Park found one of them returned positive results for legionella.

The health department says people who visited Olympic Park during August who develop symptoms of fever, chills, coughing and breathlessness should see their doctor.
